Tailored specifically for dermatological professionals like yourself who are eager to expand their knowledge and skills, our planning committee has put together an engaging program.

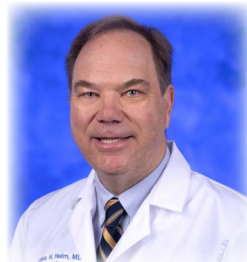
